



Fort Churchill State Historic Park Programs

The park is located eight miles south of Silver Springs on Alternate U.S. 95, and one mile on Fort Churchill Road.

What: Nevada Civil War Volunteers Encampment

When: September 26th, 10:00am-1:00pm

Where: In front of the museum

Fees: Park Entrance Fee \$4.00 per vehicle

The Nevada Civil Volunteers re-create 1860s military life and will be dressed in either military uniforms of the civil war era or in traditional clothing of the time. A mock military exercise will be conducted on the parade grounds located in the ruins.



BUCKLAND STATION

Buckland Station is located on the Carson River at Weeks Bridge, one-half mile south of the Fort Churchill entrance road.
